FLATTERING BEA settled off the pace in the three path, moved three wide entering the far turn, seized command at the quarter pole and drew clear under a drive. EASTER FASHION stalked the pace inside, briefly went three wide near the nine-sixteenths pole, angled out again near the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly to be clearly second best. GALLANT PERFORMER hesitated at the start, lagged toward the inside early, raced four wide around the far turn and was along late for the show. SHARP SARITA pressed the pace two wide and tired around the far turn. A LOVER'S QUESTION stalked the pace three wide, bid nearing the far turn, reached even terms between foes at the quarter pole then tired near the three-sixteenths marker. RING AND RUN set the pace along the rail and faltered near the quarter pole.
