DRUM ROLL was bumped at the start, raced four wide on the backstretch, chased the leaders on the turn, weakened and was clear for the show. BOBCAT JIM chased between rivals, raced in the two path on the turn and weakened. COACH A. J. was bumped at the start, chased three wide between rivals, continued three wide on the turn and tired. TAP AND TRADE chased inside and faded.
