A supplemental nomination fee of \$6,000 in addition to the entry fee can be made at any time prior to the close of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees to receive a \$1,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Any filly that competes in both the Acorn and Mother Goose will have their subscription fees waived to the Mother Goose. 121 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, May 11, 2013 with 30 Nominations. (Clear 70)

MIDNIGHT LUCKY lost her footing stumbling at the start bumping with CLOSE HATCHES as she recovered herself, attended the pace two to three wide in hand, came under light coaxing at the five-sixteenths, displaced the leader nearing the quarter pole, got set down at that station, drew clear under a drive until geared down in the final strides. CLOSE HATCHES bumped at the start as MIDNIGHT LUCKY recovered her footing bracing herself against her near side, settled four wide towards the rear albeit within aim of the leader, remained in hand until let out nearing the quarter pole, continued four wide into upper stretch, rallied no match for the top one while digging in in a good effort for the place honors. KAUAI KATIE stumbled slightly at the start, tracked the pace along the inside, came under light coaxing at the seven-sixteenths keeping close range on the front, shifted to the two path at the head of the lane cornering in behind the eventual winner, kicked on mildly through the stretch getting outfinished in the last jumps for the place. CUE THE MOON three wide towards the rear of a compact field, came under coaxing at the half mile pole to take closer order, angled five wide at the top of the stretch under a drive, offered up a mild kick by tired rivals for the last major share. LET ME ENTERTAIN U just off the solid pace three wide tracking, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, continued three wide at the quarter pole, offered no rally then weakened in the final furlong. MOMENTARY MAGIC coaxed lightly along on the pace initially from just off the inside, shifted to the rail at the nine-sixteenths, had the field take closer order three furlongs out, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths under challenge, got displaced nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch and tired through the drive.
