Chestnut Filly, (May), by Curlin - Whatdreamsrmadeof by Graeme Hall. Trainer Todd A. Pletcher. Bred by CASA Farms I, LLC (KY). CURALINA bumped hard from both sides, was squeezed at the start, raced from off the inside throughout, stlaked a trio of front runners taking the four path on the turn, closed in and issued a challenge heading into the lane, steadily chopped away at the advantage during the ensuing furlong, wore down the runner up with a few strides to spare before reaching the finish line to prove best. BY THE MOON stumbled outward, making solid contact with the breaker next door, was briefly placed along the inside down the backstretch, spun three wide on the turn and pressed the issue, issued a successful takeover as three-quarters was being completed, responded positively when given her cue, emerged at the eighth pole holding its biggest advantage, but with two others in hot pursuit, yielded reluctantly in the shadow of the wire. WONDER GAL saved ground for nearly three-quarters, was asked to pick up interest angling three wide into the stretch, teamed up with the winner shortly afterwards, flattened out slightly in the last strides and had to settle for the show. DANZATRICE raced three wide on the turn, was let out after leaving the midway point, mustered up a mild response to grab the last major check. OCEANWAVE was devoid of early speed, was in the three path when let out a notch at the three-eighths pole, picked up the pace angling sharply into the seven path during the initial portion of the stretch, failed to maintain the momentum and went on to improve position. BAR OF GOLD was taken hold after getting squeezed as the field was sent off and running, same as the eventual winner, raced towards the two path on the turn, was kept on hold caught behind some rivals during the last stages of the run around the bend, mananged to work her way into the six path from upper to midlane, failed to make up any headway late. MISS ELLA lost her footing at the start, cut over to the rail after securing control, vied to hold on to it for three-quarters and faltered. CALAMITY KATE bumped at the start, raced between rivals on the turn, had no response. CONDO COMMANDO got bumped at the start, raced parked out four wide on the turn, had little left for the stretch and backed away. PROMISE ME SILVER lost her footing being released from the gate, rushed up and worked out a tuck into the two path by the conclustion of the backstretch, remained a forward factor for most of the way on the turn then gave4 way. LIGHT THE CITY appeared to get clipped from behind in the early stages, raced two wide and failed to reach a contending position. SHOOK UP took her first step inward in an awkward manner, brushed with another a few strides late, went onward for a bit and stumbled after appearing to clip the heels of LIGHT THE CITY, had the rider lose the irons for a brief period, was guided onto the inside route, lost her best action midpoint on the turn, turrned for home under a protective hold, was eased across the wire and subsequently vanned off after the finish.
