6 $\frac{1}{2}$  FURLONGS. (1.133) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 *ADIRONDACK S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD.* By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race held at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible to receive a one time \$100,000 bonus should that horse go on to win a graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2014. The bonus will be reflected in the horse's earnings. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs. A Trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 26, 2014 with 16 Nominations. (Clear 83)

**Bay Filly, (Feb), by Bernardini - Promenade Girl by Carson City. Trainer McLaughlin P. Kiaran. Bred by Swettenham Stud(KY).**

CAVORTING came away in good order, settled on the outside, dropped in a bit leaving the backstretch, went three wide early on the turn, shifted four wide then advanced approaching the five-sixteenths, chased into upper stretch, made a bid at the furlong marker, had the rider wield a left-handed whip at that point, showing the aforementioned whip directly in front of ANGELA RENEE, battled with that rival under continued left-hand urging into the final sixteenth then edged clear under strong handling. ANGELA RENEE showed good speed, moved up to the hindquarters of VIVIAN DA BLING near the five-eighths pole, shifted out shortly thereafter, chased on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, drew even with the leader while between horses at the furlong marker, battled with the winner into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while clear for the place. WONDER GAL settled on the inside, moved up with five furlongs to run, was coaxed along while along the rail on the turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, chased the vanguard into the final furlong, was in tight along the rail at the sixteenth-pole and safely secured the show. VIVIAN DA BLING broke out and bumped soundly with EMPRESSIVE HUMOR, recovered quickly then showed good speed, set the pace while off the inside, was put to the whip at the top of the stretch, lost the advantage at the furlong marker and tired. TAKE CHARGE BRANDI was reluctant to load, raced just off the pace while coaxed along, chased four wide on the turn and came up empty. PHOENIX PARK was fractious in the gate, settled at the rear of the field, was urged along while in the three path on the turn and failed to threaten. EMPRESSIVE HUMOR was bumped hard at the start and forced out, settled last but one, was urged along in the two path on the turn and failed to respond.
