WASHINGTON BRIDGE saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn, swung out into the stretch and finished with interest. JET BLUE GIRL chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. CHURCH CAMP stalked the pace inside, went outside a rival on the second turn, split foes three deep into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ELLAFITZ four wide early, stalked outside a rival then bid alongside a foe and took the lead on the backstretch, dueled for command, was in a bit tight between horses in upper stretch and also weakened.
