SAGINAW was put to a snug hold and taken back after displaying some eagerness in the early going, tracked the front runners from the pocket, crept up towards them leaving the half mile pole to slightly improve position, remained under a firm hold idling behind a wall of three rivals spread outward from the inside approaching the quarter pole, found room to maneuver to the outside and did so spinning into the stretch, competed the move with clearance along the three path for the taking, was given his cue and gradually began to pick up the pace, closed in more readily once beyond the furlong grounds, reached even terms with the runner up and after racing head to head with that opponent for several strides, wrested away the lead and edged away in the final seventy yards. FIDDLERS AFLEET prompted the leader from the two path, arrived at the end of the bend and challenged in earnest, was the first to reach the eighth pole, albeit by the slimmest of margins, and with both the winner, parked to his outside, and MINE OVER MATTER, down along the fence each making menacing moves of their own, yielded to the top one well past the sixteenth pole after putting up a fight. MINE OVER MATTER broke inward awkwardly, quickly tucked over to the rail and rode it until the three-eighths pole, tipped into the two path, continued to bide time, under a good hold by the pilot, was guided over to the inside during the initial portion of the stretch drive, launched a rail run to loom a threat shortly afterwards, flattened out. FLYING ZEALOUS vied for command from near the inside, came under intensified pressure from the primary pursuer after completing the opening half and was let out in response, relinquished with about an eighth remaining and steadily weakened. WILLY BEAMIN underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn and gave way.
