Any filly that competed in the Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont Park and the Alabama will have their entry fee waived for the Alabama. 121 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 8, 2009 with 23 Nominations. (Clear 77)

Gray or Roan Filly, (Mar), by Tapit - Sweet and Careless by Hennessy. Trainer Carroll Josie. Bred by Gainesway Thoroughbreds Ltd. and BillAndrade(KY).

CARELESS JEWEL steadied sharply inside BE FAIR on the first turn then angled outside that rival, pressed the pace from outside along the backstretch, quickly closed the gap on the turn, took charge opening a clear advantage nearing the quarter pole, shook loose in upper stretch then drew off with authority under strong left hand encouragement. MILWAUKEE APPEAL stalked the pace while three wide on the backstretch, raced just behind the leaders to the turn, launched a bid four wide in upper stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. CASANOVA MOVE settled in good position for six furlongs, rallied along the inside to reach contention on the turn, swung four wide at the quarter pole then finished willingly in the middle of the track to gain a share. SWEET AND FLAWLESS raced well back in the four path along the backstretch, angled to the rail midway on the turn, closed a bit in upper stretch and improved her position with a mild late rally. DON'T FORGET GIL checked between horses in the early stages, angled in, saved ground for seven furlongs and lacked a strong closing response. BE FAIR angled in on the first turn, raced uncontested on the lead for six furlongs, relinquished the lead to the winner on the turn and gave way thereafter. WYNNING RIDE raced well back to the turn checked and altered course wide at the three-sixteenths pole and lacked a further response while drifting out in the stretch. FUNNY MOON steadied behind the winner on the first turn, raced in midpack for a half, lodged a four wide move to reach contention on the turn then drifted out while tiring.
