ALPHA was hustled from the start then urged along on the inside, came under a strong ride while inside early on the turn, moved off the rail while advancing near the five-sixteenths pole, stormed to the front in upper stretch and drew away under steady urging. INVOCATION settled well off the pace while under some urging, shifted four wide midway through the turn, continued four wide into the stretch, moved out some while under a drive near the three-sixteenths pole, came in approaching the furlong marker, was straightened by the rider and finished willingly for the place. AFRICANIST bobbed at the start, was ridden along on the outside, went four then five wide on the turn, moved into second in upper stretch and proved no match for the winner then was caught for the place. GO WEST was urged along in the second flight, went two then three wide on the turn, moved to four wide outside the quarter-pole and failed to rally. HIERRO was slowest into stride, raced well back in the field, went three then two wide on the turn, steadied outside the quarter-pole, dropped to the inside, moved out in upper stretch, drifted out under a left-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and improved position. TIMELY TALLY raced well off the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, was carried in near the furlong marker and failed to threaten. JULIUS CAESAR settled off the pace, dropped to the inside midway through the turn, moved back off the rail around the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole, came under a drive and failed to respond. LITTLE WYATT sprinted clear while hard to rate, raced with his mouth wide open, held a sizeable advantage on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and faded. A CAT THAT FLIES was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide early on the turn, dropped towards the inside and faltered. NANDINO was urged along on the outside, dropped back while three wide on the turn and stopped.
