1 1/4 MILES. (1.41) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 *ALYSHEBA S. (GRADE II) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$300 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$9,000 at time of entry. \$1,500 to pass the entry box; \$1,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes at a mile or over since November 1, allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade II stakes at a mile or over or \$90,000 over a mile since October 31, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Alysheba will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest 2013-2014 earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Closed Wednesday, April 9, 2014 with 55 nominations. (Clear 55)

MOONSHINE MULLIN set the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the far turn with a long drive in the stretch and prevailed in the final stages. GOLDEN TICKET chased the early pace, made a bid three wide entering the lane with a long drive late in the stretch but was outfinished. COIN BROKER was well placed early, shifted into the four path in the far turn while making a bid but flattened out late in the stretch run. MYLUTE was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn with some late gain in the stretch drive. BRADESTER stalked the early pace, was in the four path entering the lane and faded late. WILL TAKE CHARGE was on the inside into the far turn with no late bid in the stretch. GOLDEN SOUL showed little. APPEALING TALE was being fractious in the gate during the pre-start, hopped and broke awkwardly at the start, rushed up to the front to pressure the pace, was in tight in the stretch and eased late while drifting out.
