GLOBAL VIEW was unhurried into stride, took closer order through second turn, shifted out seven wide entering the stretch, dug in under

left handed urging, reeled in the leader and was up in the final yards. STORMING INTI tracked the leader three deep under a snug hold, poked

his head in front after a half, shook clear nearing the furlong marker, fought on well but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. QUOTIENT was pocketed along the shrub under a hard hold, tugged on between rivals while forwardly placed, tipped out entering the stretch to be clear,

GENERAL JACK bumped with PICOZŽA at the start, was in tight between horses entering the first turn, tucked in to find room, slipped through entering the stretch but failed to make headway through the drive. WOODFIELD SPRINGS settled in hand four wide, moved up between horses on the second turn but failed to sustain the drive. PICOZZA bumped with GENERAL JACK at the start, was close up four wide to the stretch, but faltered between rivals and faded. CHIEF BARKER (IRE) broke slow, was unhurried and passed only the tiring ones. CLEBURNE

but flattened once uncovered and settled for the show. LONG ON VALUE was rank to place between rivals early, moved out five wide on the backstretch and leveled into stride, ranged into striking distance through the second turn, but weakened in the final furlong and finished evenly.

was never a factor. CRAFTSMAN (IRE) opened clear to set the pace, was headed after a half, disputed the issue through the second turn and stopped.
