Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (M<sup>ay</sup>), by Lemon Drop Kid - Shytoe Lafete by King of Kings (IRE). Trainer Bauer A. Philip. Bred by Avalon Farms, Inc.(KY).

ANOTHER LEMON DROP raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled nicely off the pace, moved up late on the backstretch, slipped through along the rail to take the lead midway through the far turn, edged clear when asked leaving that bend and drew away under steady handling. DISTANT KINGDOM went four then three wide on the first turn, was rated in the second flight while on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, bumped with a rival at the five-sixteenths pole, had the rider lose his whip at the top of the stretch and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. CHATITO went to the front, raced a bit off the rail on the first turn, set the pace, lost the advantage while in the two path on the far turn and gave way. FANTASIZE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was ridden along while inside on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch, had the rider lose his whip and improved position. PATERNAL PRIDE went three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while off the rail early on the far turn, skimmed by a stopping rival at the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to the rail late on that bend, moved out in the drive and just missed the minor awards. INDYGO BO was very rank off heels on the first turn then rated off the pace, waited while caught behind rivals from the seven-sixteenths pole to the three-eighths pole, was roused after finding room shortly thereafter, chased into the stretch and tired. MAN OF STATURE was rank through the first turn then reserved off the pace, went three to four wide on the far turn, swerved out over heels late on that bend and failed to rally. LET US BE GLAD bumped lightly with an opponent at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. INDICT went two to three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn, bumped with DISTANT KINGDOM while dropping back at the five-sixteenths and stopped.
