EUPHONY stalked the early pace, made a rail bid then was roused at the top of the stretch and drew clear then held sway. KISS WITH A TWIST was squeezed at the start then was void of speed while under a tight hold, circled the field in the turn and got up late for place.

INDESCRIBABLE moved up on the backstretch and rallied in the turn then ducked in to the rail in the stretch and ran on. HOME'S THE BEST showed no speed, made a rail move then was shut off in the stretch and was closing late. SKY MOM rated in the second flight inside, angled out while looking for a hole at the top of the stretch but was shut off and made no rally. SERENADING stumbled badly at the start then ranged up while five wide on the turn but flattened out. BOUDOIR was rushed up and set the pace, led to the stretch then tired. GLORIA GOODBODY settled between horses, altered course to avoid the fallen foe in the stretch then made no rally. BORN TO BE raced close up between horses, was boxed in at the top of the stretch then clipped heels and fell. FOLLOWING A STEWARD'S INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN, #1 SKY MOM WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED LAST FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WITH #6 BORN TO BE.
