PACHATTACK, held up off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out after five furlongs to split foes racing into the far turn, gained a narrow advantage after six furlongs, forged clear racing into upper stretch and extended her advantage under brisk handling. LA GRAN BAILADORA was settled along the inside in the opening half, shifted off the inside gathering momentum entering the far turn, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and edged a rival for place honors. HOME'S THE BEST hopped at the start, was guided to the inside racing unhurried in the opening half, steadily drew into contention inside foes entering the second bend, split foes racing through the far turn to move into second but couldn't gain terms with the winner and was outfinished for place honors late. UPPERLINE, caught four wide racing into the first turn while moving to secure a position in the second flight, dropped off the leaders a bit midway through the backstretch, advanced to challenge three deep between foes entering the far turn but lacked the needed final response. IT'S TEA TIME angled inwards in early stages to track off the second flight under some reserve racing to the backstretch, continued near the inside on the far turn to challenge along the rail entering upper stretch but had no final response. MILWAUKEE APPEAL tracked the pace between foes three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, was caught four wide racing through the far turn and steadily faded entering upper stretch. SATANS QUICK CHICK settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. SANTINA DOND went to the fore along the inside racing to the backstretch but emptied out once headed after six furlongs. SHE'S ALL IN shifted off the inside tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight but quickly retreated after a half.
