LA TIA broke sharply, moved to the rail dictating terms to her rivals on a comfortable margin under rating racing into the backstretch, continued in that fashion to the second bend, responded when prompted to go clear racing into upper stretch and steadily widened her margin to the end under firm handling. FRIVOLOUS angled to the inside early stalking just off the pacesetter under light reserve racing into the backstretch, was urged to advance racing into upper stretch while losing some position to the eventual winner, then shifted outside a drifting rival in the closing stages to narrowly prevail for the place honors on the wire. AWESOME FLOWER was urged to gain terms with the leader attending that rivals' pace in the opening stages, was urged to prompt that foe racing into the far turn, couldn't match the leader racing into upper stretch, then drifted inwards under pressure late while just missing for second. AMBUSER tracked off the second flight along the inside under light rating racing into the backstretch, shifted out three wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly in that path to gain some position while just missing for a share. MOMENT IN DIXIE settled into stride while angling inside early, saved ground to upper stretch to gain some position inside foes but made no real impression. I DAZZLE tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing to the far turn but offered no rally. HEART OF DESTINY, held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, trailed the field to the stretch. NAPLES GOLD delayed proceedings prior to the start when requiring a shoe repair, was urged to gain a forward placing three deep racing into the first turn, continued outside a rival in the second flight for six furlongs and steadily faded racing through the far turn.
