 LITTLE MIKE set the pace along the inside, came out for the stretch run and opened a clear advantage inside the eighth pole, then was fully extended to hold sway. RIVIERA COCKTAIL unhurried while saving ground, angled wide for room at the top of the stretch and finished full of run to be up for the place. ASPHALT allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run and closed well while being edged for the place. MIKOSHI rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then weakened. SUCCESSFUL MISSION was caught out four wide around the first turn, moved up down the backstretch to chase LITTLE MIKE into the stretch, then gave way. CHEROKEE ARTIST chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then tired. NICANOR showed early foot, eased back leaving the first turn to save ground, then faltered in the drive. COMMANDEERED chased the pace along the rail into the stretch, then faded.
