ART FAN, rated back early while off the rail, quickly gained four wide into the lane, lodged a bid near mid stretch, took command soon after and edged away under left handed urging. SASSY LOVE, two wide to clear into the backstretch, dictated the pace towards the inside, was collared in mid stretch and stayed on gamely. HUMORISTIC, five wide down the backstretch while not far back, continued off the inside into the lane and finished willingly. REDASPEN, unhurried early, raced four wide in mid stretch and offered a mild response. TAKE A CHECK vied inside around the first turn, rated back to stalk the pace, raced forwardly to upper stretch then gave way. MARCHONIN, allowed to settle, made a run along the rail mid way on the final turn then faded in the drive. THETACTICS OFDANCE never seriously threatened. ROWDY failed to respond. LATICE (IRE) saved ground, came up empty and was vanned off. COZY GAIN, pinched back at the break, lost ground four wide and failed to respond. LATITUDE FORTY, used five wide into the first turn, stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs and faltered. SWEET SCIENCE, between rivals early stalking the pace, faltered.
