Bay Horse, (Sep), by Easing Along - Suffrage by Horse Chestnut (SAF). Trainer McAnally L. Ronald. Bred by Haras Futuro SRL(ARG).

SUGGESTIVE BOY (ARG) pulled his way along four wide then stalked three deep, came out four wide into the stretch, gained the lead outside foes in midstretch, kicked clear while drifting in under urging and proved best. WILKINSON chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch, bid between rivals in midstretch, could not match the winner but was game for second. SILENTIO stalked three deep then bid three wide between foes a half mile out, tracked outside on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and just gained the show. AKKADIAN chased between horses or outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, rallied between foes in the stretch and split horses on the line. KLISZ saved ground chasing the pace, went between horses on the second turn, split rivals in midstretch and again at the wire. FOREST MOUSE chased inside, was shuffled back into the second turn, continued along the rail, came off the fence in the drive and was in tight between horses in deep stretch and could not offer the needed rally. CHOSEN MIRACLE had speed outside rivals then angled in, set the pace inside, dueled leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, fought back along the rail in the stretch and weakened late. TRIBAL TRIBUTE stalked a bit off the rail then inside, bid between horses a half mile out and outside the pacesetter on the second turn, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. VAGABOND SHOES (IRE) pulled his way along toward the inside then a bit off the rail, continued just off the fence on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the needed response in the lane. WILLYCONKER (IRE) between horses early, chased outside a rival then three deep into and on the second turn, came out five wide into the stretch and did not rally. STRONG SUIT reluctant to load, threw his head, hopped and broke slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn then angled back in again for the stretch, was taken off the rail in the drive and was not a threat. KEY DECISION (ARG) four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep, bid four wide a half mile out, fell back outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and weakened. SEBASTIAN FLYTE (GB) pulled between horses early, chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, dropped back four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
