ARCHWARRIOR came away from the starting gate with no apparent mishap, was given several choppy strokes near the right shoulder as early motivation, picked up the pace noticeably late down the backstretch and latched on to TRANSPARENT upon reaching the half mile pole, gradually ranged up during the run around the bend three wide, under some light hand encouragement while doing so, turned for home on even terms with a now much more strongly handled opponent and was asked for more himself, shook free and arrived at the eighth pole with no other alongside from either side, increased the advantage, kept to a brisk hand ride to the end. MALACHITE chased the pace dispute from off the inside, got angled outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole and was soon called upon, fell back steadily departing the furlong grounds, went the final six strides or so under his own power. UNLIKELY SCENARIO tracked the front runners from the pocket for the opening half, got angled out in upper stretch and proved no match for the top twosome. TRANSPARENT was hand urged to clear the field and grab the early advantage, took up residence in the two path, had the top one slowly but steadily close in on the turn, was under a drive by the quarter pole, possessing only the narrowest of leads by this juncture, got shaken off soon afterwards and gave way. BUDDY'S TIZ briefly rode the rail, tipped into the two path coming to the half mile pole, chased the duel for about a half and tired. OVERNIGHT TRADING took the inside route and faltered. MORE FALLING STAR ducked in awkwardly at the break, was likewise given some early motivation with the stick near the right shoulder, failed to respond, saved ground thereafter and was always outrun.
