1 MILE. (1.332) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 ARLINGTON-WASHINGTON LASSIE S. FOR FILLIES, TWO-YEARS-OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination. A Supplementary Nomination of \$2,000 may be made on Wednesday, September 4, 2013, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHT: 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 once other than Maiden or Claiming, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 once or a race other than Maiden or Claiming, allowed 4 lbs. This event will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Highweights prefer red. Preference to horses of equal weight will be Highest Total Earnings in 2013. Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees with the exception of the nominating fee(s). Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Offlee Wild - La Belle by Dixie Union. Trainer Scherer R. Richard. Bred by Dr. Jacqueline Smith(KY).

SHE'S OFFLEE GOOD took up a position between foes just off the second flight while being rated out of close quarters in the opening stages, angled to the rail nearing the turn while continuing with a steady effort under light reserve, switched out four deep nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance and continued with a solid late response to wrest command and kick clear under firm handling.

SWEETSOUTHERNDAME tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance racing five deep in the second flight on the backstretch, continued in that path through the bend while steadily advancing to contention, then made steady progress outside foes in late stages to just prevail for place honors. MARIA MARIA tracked off the second flight while angling inwards to race outside a rival in the opening half, steadily drew into contention while angling to the inside racing through the turn, moved to challenge between rivals near the inside racing through the stretch but was just outkicked. TAMAZULA broke inwards, was urged to gain a position inside foes in the second flight in the opening quarter, steadily drew into contention while shifting out three deep nearing upper stretch, continued to dispute the issue in that path between foes past midstretch but failed to sustain her momentum. ISTANFORD shifted in sharply just after the break while being prompted to gain a forward placing, switched outside the pacesetter in the second furlong while being prompted to maintain striking distance, continued with a steady bid to press the issue on the turn, gained the advantage racing into upper stretch but yielded nearing the sixteenth marker. BATTLEFIELD ANGEL bobbed at the start, settled between foes in the last flight racing to the turn, shifted out to split foes three deep gaining some position racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while caught in close quarters late. GUMDROP settled along the rail in the last flight early, shifted off the inside racing into the bend, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and gained some position while making no real impression. BELLARADA tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail racing into the turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. RICHIES SWEETHEART sped to the fore while angling to the rail once gaining the advantage, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn and gave out racing into upper stretch. DIVERGENT VIEW was a brief factor four wide between foes in the second flight but was through after a half. LOOK WHO'S HERE hopped at the start losing position to the field, settled outside foes and never gained contention.
