GENERAL ELECTION was reserved saving ground tracking well off the second flight in the opening half, made a steady advance to contention along the rail racing into upper stretch, shifted out in the closing stages making some light contact with GEFEST but edged forward in time under firm right handed encouragement. ADMIRAL KITTEN, reserved outside a rival in the last flight racing to the backstretch, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch and made steady late progress to gain the place honors while just failing to edge the winner. DORSETT was steadied in close quarters near the inside in the opening stages, switched outside foes to track off the second flight, moved to challenge four wide nearing upper stretch, continued to dispute the issue in that path through the lane, drifted inwards in late stages making some contact with GEFEST and was just outkicked by the top pair. GEFEST hopped at the start, was pulling a bit along the inside tracking just off the pacesetter racing into the backstretch, switched out leaving the far turn to bid three deep between foes racing into upper stretch, continued to contest the issue past midstretch and was squeezed between foes late while being outfinished for a share. PROCUREMENT settled between foes out of striking distance for five furlongS, moved to split foes three deep leaving the far turn while being prompted to advance, shifted out five wide racing through the stretch and was just outkicked for a share. WHISKEY BRAVO tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening half, angled to the inside nearing upper stretch and made an effort to gain some position inside foes. BELLS BIG BERNIE sped clear of the field into the first turn, dictated the pace on his own courage to the second bend, maintained that advantage to upper stretch but emptied out leaving the furlong marker. YORKSHIRE ICON (GB), reserved along the inside while racing in some close quarters midway through the backstretch, never gained contention. BROWN ALMIGHTY tracked off the second flight along the inside to the far turn, switched out nearing upper stretch to bid between foes but quickly came up empty. BAMBAZONKI was settled outside foes tracking off the second flight four wide racing into the backstretch, was fanned five wide nearing the lane but lacked the needed rally. BOBO tracked the leader outside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn but emptied out racing into upper stretch. FORDUBAI, pulling and a bit rank while held up in close quarters early, tracked off the second flight to the far turn, lodged a brief, three wide bid between foes on the second bend but retreated early. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF GEFEST LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER AND THE RIDER OF DORSETT ALLEGING INTERFERENCE. THE TRAINER OF GEFEST LODGED A CONCURRENT CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THOSE SAME HORSES. FOLLOWING A REVIEW OF THE INCIDENT IN THE STRETCH, THE STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED DORSETT FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM FOURTH.
