JOURNEY ON sent along outside to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back along the rail on the second turn and through the stretch, could not quite match the winner late but held second. CHARLIE EM (GB) stalked between horses then a bit off the rail on the backstretch, continued inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and finished willingly. NEED YOU NOW (IRE) pulled her way along to stalk three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the backstretch, bid between horses on the second turn and in the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. OSCAR PARTY angled in and chased inside, steadied off heels on the first turn and again early on the backstretch, came out nearing the second turn and three deep into the stretch and had a mild late bid. INCLUDE THE AUSSIE was unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came out in midstretch and improved position. FLASHY WAYS pulled between horses then outside a rival and steadied on the first turn, stalked alongside a foe or between horses, came three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. WITTGENSTEIN (IRE) hopped slightly at the start, chased between horses most of the way to the stretch and did not rally. HEIR KITTY saved ground and steadied off heels on the first turn, chased inside, came out nearing the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MISS EMPIRE came off the inside on the first turn, chased outside on the backstretch and second turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. CARAQUISTA pulled a bit off the rail then angled in and steadied off heels on the first
