QUALITY ROCKS bumped the inside foe lightly at the start then went in tandem with that one to the fore, settled just off her flank pressing the early pace, moved to challenge late on the turn, wrested command at the top of the stretch, began to edge away under urging in upper stretch then once in command was given just intermittent reminders while extending the advantage late. SARAH SIS was bumped lightly by the winner at the break, willingly went to the lead to set the pace inside under moderate pressure, edged away just a bit heading into the turn then faced the winner's challenge leaving that bend, succumbed to her in upper stretch but kept on to be well clear of the remainder and second best. HAPPY TO GO was bumped hard at the start, raced in the three or four path bringing up the rear, went three wide into the turn and emerged four wide for the stretch run, finished well to capture show honors. PUNTSVILLE broke on top then took back to stalk the leading pair while racing in the three to four path early, came three wide on the turn while still within striking distance but lacked the needed late kick. SUSAN'S DAY broke in and bumped a rival hard at the start, angled to the two path soon after the start, pulled against the rider's restraint leaving the backstretch and had to tap on the breaks just past the nine-sixteenths pole, continued near the inside to the quarter pole then came out a path, angled four wide nearing the sixteenth pole and ultimately had no rally. LEMON GALA was a beat slow at the start then moved forward to obtain position tracking the leaders along the rail, saved ground on the turn, had no late rally. SUGAR TALK raced between runners through much of the run up the backstretch and on the turn, dropped back, faded.
