BABY J needed several attempts before being successfully loaded into the starting gate, came out with no apparent mishap and moved under her own power to take control, sat on open early lead, near the inside and with the pilot applying a firm hold on the reins, got pounced upon by a pair of foes coming to the five-sixteenths pole and was soon let out a notch in response to their sudden challenge, entered the stretch and was put to stronger handling, kicked clear of the others, emerging from the furlong grounds in possession of her biggest advantage, saw that margin cut into steadily by SEASONED WARRIOR thereafter but held on safely. SEASONED WARRIOR allowed to settle into stride, raced towards the winner in tandem with LIVE LIVELY parked one path wider soon after entering the turn, fell back from the five-sixteenths pole to midstretch once the top one was called upon for some run, staged a good comeback in the final furlong but had to settle for the place. LIVE LIVELY issued a three wide bid coming to the five-sixteenths pole and flattened out. LUCKY FRIEND bobbed after taking an awkward step at the start, was quickly taken to the inside, appeared eager in the initial stages, tugging on the bit, was steadied in upper turn after nearly running up on another's heels, vacated the rail leaving the three-eighths pole and went about more professionally, spun from the two path under encouragement into the stretch, lacked the needed response. MAKE ME A PROPHET out slightly at the break, was pulled off the nearest opponent before any significant contact could be made, took the inside route, was tiring when angled outward past the furlong grounds.
