BATTLE OF HASTINGS (GB) pulled his way along three deep then stalked outside, continued three wide leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch, gained the lead under urging in deep stretch and proved best. **FLASHMANS PAPERS (GB)** stalked off the rail then inside on the hill, bid along the fence then came out in midstretch, gained a short lead but could not match the winner late. **LUCKIEST MAN** sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then angled in, came out into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and weakened but held third. **DREAM NOW** chased outside then off the rail, went three deep leaving the hill and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. **BEAUTEOUS MAXIMUS** settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the hill, swung four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. **BROTHER KEITH** bobbed at the start, pulled hard between horses early then stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the hill, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. **PREEMO** chased inside, moved up into the stretch, bid along the inside past the eighth pole then broke down in deep stretch and was vanned off. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
