1 1/4 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.453) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 **BERNARD BARUCH H. (GRADE II) INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD.** No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. All starters will receive a \$1,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divi ded equally among remaining finishers. Any horse that competes in both the Fourstardave Handicap and the Bernard Baruch Handicap will have their entry fee waived for this race. **DIRT** Weights: Three year olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs. Non-winners of a Grad ed Sweepstake on the dirt in 2008-09 allowed 2 lbs.; \$40,000 on the dirt in 2008-09, 4 lbs.; four races on the dirt, 6 lbs.; three races on the dirt, 8 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A Trophy will be presented to the winning ow ner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 15, 20 09 with 34 Nominations. (Cloudy 66)

Bay Colt, (Feb), by Distorted Humor - Justenuffheart by Broad Brush. Trainer McLaughlin P. Kiaran. Bred by Mt. Brilliant Farm LLC (KY).

JUSTENUFFHUMOR was rated in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, raced in hand to the far turn, launched a rally from outside midway on the turn, swung five wide while rapidly gaining at the quarter pole then closed strongly in the middle off the track to wear down COWBOY CAL under strong left and urging. COWBOY CAL pressed early, opened a clear advantage before going a half, set the pace in hand for six furlongs, extended his advantage in upper stretch, maintained a clear lead into deep stretch then yielded grudgingly. SETTE E MEZZO was rated in the middle of the pack for five furlongs, closed the gap three wide leaving the turn then finished well between horses to gain a share. SEASPEAK set or forced the pace into upper stretch and weakened in midstretch. MAMBO MEISTER checked in traffic on the first turn, raced in good position for six furlongs, swung out while gaining on the turn and finished evenly. INTERPATATION was outrun after breaking a bit slowly, raced well back to the turn, circled six wide into the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. COLONY (IRE) was rated between horses for five furlongs, advanced three wide to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. DEAL MAKING failed to threaten while saving ground. YATE'S BLACK CAT steadied in traffic on the first turn and failed to threaten thereafter. KUTAIS raced up close to the far turn and gave way.
