TURALLURE was steadied while in tight between rivals soon after the start, one of several crowded a few jumps from the gate by BOOTS AHEAD, settled along the inside towards the back of the pack before reaching the opening turn, was eased off the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, improved position during the run around the far turn, swung five wide into the lane and got called upon, closed in with good energy down the outside of the course, sustained the momentum leaving the furlong grounds, collared GET SUNNY with about a sixteenth to go, and edged away, crossing the finish line under hand encouragement. GET STORMY showed good early speed, quickly cleared the field to take control, tucked over to the inside, was well rated until the quarter pole, was let out after settling into upper stretch and kicked away to a comfortable advantage, felt the top one's presence approaching the sixteenth pole, yielded soon afterwards but held well for the place. BARYSHNIKOV was steadied after being herded into tight quarters amongst rivals a short distance from the starting gate, rated kindly in midpack from off the inside, got asked for a response entering the stretch and came home willingly for the show. BOOTS AHEAD began to angle gradually towards the inside leaving the starting gate, causing crowding, with the result of having several rivals being forced to steady once placed in tight quarters, sat well placed slightly off the inside, was asked for a response in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, remained a prominent factor until the eighth pole, weakened steadily thereafter. MORYBA (BRZ) underwent a three to four wide journey and had no kick. HYMN BOOK between rivals for a good portion of the way around the far turn, failed to fire once called upon. PARIS VEGAS saved ground and was no factor. LOUP BRETON (IRE) three wide at the three-eighths pole, failed to menace. INTERACTION (ARG) steadied after the start, angled outward for the stretch drive, came up empty. BEAU CHOIX checked after being herded into tight quarters after the start, raced along the outside and was outrun. BLUES STREET attended the pacesetter, three wide until midway on the second turn, folded.
