MARCH three to four wide near the rear, came under encouragement three wide with five-sixteenths to run, swung four wide into upper stretch, rallied the outermost of a quintet stacked across the track nearing the eighth pole, leaned slightly on READY FOR RYE for a stride at that station before seizing command inside that marker, inched away briefly before coming under threat by LORD NELSON through the final seventy yards, drifted slightly under a near sided stick repelling that danger to the wire. LORD NELSON climbed early on inside behind rivals resenting the kickback, had the rider angle him well wide five to six paths through the turn coming under urging near the five-sixteenths, swung six wide into upper stretch, offered up good late energy to close well through the final sixteenth but was ultimately rebuffed to the line. READY FOR RYE just off the pace just off the inside in pursuit under encouragement from three furlongs out, spun three wide for home, rallied between foes stacked four wide nearing the eighth pole, got bumped very lightly when poking a head in front a furlong out and in turn leaned slightly on EASY TO SAY inside tightening an already tight rail for ACKERET, got headed inside that station and weakened in the late stages while safely garnering the show.
