entering the stretch, angled to the hedge and gamely earned the place. HONEY RYDER settled near the inside early, was put to a drive

between foes entering the far turn, worked her way outside the winner to be seven wide for the final furlong and managed a mild gain. WAIT A

WHILE tracked the pace four wide into the upper stretch, remained a factor into the final furlong and came up empty. SATWA QUEEN (FR),
