Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Stormy Atlantic - Jewell of Jewels by Pleasant Colony. Trainer Tagg Barclay. Bred by Adena Springs (FL).

MY PRINCESS JESS steadied between horses on the first turn, was under a firm hold while between horses for five furlongs, swung three wide while gaining on the turn, rapidly gained to challenge in midstretch, took command a sixteenth out and edged clear under good handling. CARRIBEAN SUNSET (IRE) settled in good position for a half, closed the gap three wide to threaten on the turn, lodged a bid outside the leader in midstretch, but couldn't stay with the winner through the final eighth while narrowly holding for the place. SOCIAL QUEEN was outrun along the backstretch, angled three wide while advancing three wide at the quarter pole and finished strongly in the middle of the track to gain a share. SUNSHINE FOR LIFE pressed the pace in the two path, accelerated to the front on the turn, led into midstretch and weakened late. SCOLARA checked in traffic early, was unhurried along the inside, raced in traffic on the turn, swung out and rallied mildly. FOLLOW MY DREAM raced well back while three wide to the turn and lacked a strong closing response. DYNA'S LASSIE raced in good position along the inside to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. BORROWING BASE dropped back at the start and was never close thereafter. ARE WE DREAMIN set the pace on the rail for nearly six furlongs and gave way.
