1 $\frac{1}{4}$ MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.391) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *BEAUGAY S. (GRADE III) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD.* No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$1,000 may be made at time of entry. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. All entrants will be required to pay entry and start fees. The purse to be divided %60 to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 117.; Older 122. Turf weights. Non-winners of a Graded sweepstakes twice on the turf since October 31, 2009 allowed 3 lbs.; such a race on the turf since then, 5 lbs.; non-winners of \$50,000 on the turf in 2009-10, 7 lbs. Dirt weights. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes on the dirt or a sweepstake on the dirt in 2010 allowed, 3 lbs. Four races on the dirt, 5 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, dirt all allowance weights will apply and it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Dynaformer - Slews Final Answer by Seattle Slew. Trainer Benzel Seth. Bred by Live Oak Stud (FL).

DYNASLEW established control before reaching the backstretch, was well rated towards the inside while setting a moderate pace, maintained a clear advantage around the far turn, while still keeping plenty in reserve, responded positively once roused in the vicinity of the quarter pole, drew off to a sizeable advantage with an eighth to go and increased her winning margin while remaining under active handling. SCOLARA saved ground throughout and came home willingly to garner place honors, never posing a threat at any point during the stretch drive. CHESTORIA took the inside route, angled outward at the head of the stretch, and displayed a kick worthy enough of show honors. MY PRINCESS JESS well positioned three wide around both turns under rating tactics, lacked the needed response after called upon in the lane. MISS WORLD rated attending the pacesetter from the outside for six furlongs, tired. LIBERALLY (IRE) raced towards the inside and lacked a rally. STRIKE THE BELL was no factor. PUMPKIN SHELL broke on top, holding the lead for a few strides, dropped back quickly on the opening bend and was never involved thereafter.
