WATERWAY RUN three wide for most of the way along the chute, worked out a tuck closer to the rail coming to the main course, sat reserved, racing between rivals on the full turn, picked up the pace when asked to prior to spinning three wide into the stretch, was given her cue and responded positively, was one of a plethora with a fighting chance for victory at the end of the run through the furlong grounds, forged her way to a slim advantage with under a sixteenth remaining, then dug in gamely to preserve it. ORION MOON (FR) underwent a ground-saving journey, was forced to be kept on hold nearing the quarter pole, had the former leader, that being ASSATEAGUE, drift towards the two path during the opening phases of the stretch run, launched a rail rally once sufficient room to do so had been attained, loomed boldly as did several others at the beginning of the final furlong, slipped by in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole to gain a slim and short-lived advantage, couldn't protect it against the winner, but continued onward gamely to take the place. BYRAMA (GB) rode the rail, loosely drafted behind the second place finisher, remained unasked for her best heading for the quarter pole, lacking suitable options like the last referred-to rival, gained room to maneuver and was forced to fan all the way to the five path to secure a usable lane, came home with good energy en route for the show. SCAMPERING reluctant to load into the starting gate, proceeded to come away in good as did all the others, was strung out four wide proceeding down the chute, raced slightly closer to the rail on the full turn, commenced the stretch four wide, remained prominently placed before flattening out late. ENGLISH CLASS broke on top, offered strong resistance on the bit while conceding the front to ASSATEAGUE soon afterwards, stalked that rival for just over three-quarters, challenged in earnest heading home, kept up the pursuit to past the eighth pole before weakening late. ASSATEAGUE took over from ENGLISH CLASS shortly after the start, tucked along the rail, was rated while setting the splits, with ENGLISH CLASS in close attendance parked out in the two path, got called upon heading for the top of the lane as the pressure greatly picked up, dug in with good determination before yielding for good with about a sixteenth to go. IRISH MISSION three wide to the quarter pole, ventured over towards the six path after entering the stretch, trailed.
