2 MILES. (Turf) (3:22) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 Belmont Gold Cup Invitational S.FOR FOUR- YEAR- OLDS AND UPWARD. By invitation only with no nomination, entry or starting fees. The purse will be divided as follows \$137,500 to the owner of the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth, \$7,500 to fifth, \$5,000 to sixth with the remaining \$5,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$200,000 at a mile or over in 2014-15 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2014-15, 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred at a mile or over in 2015, 6 lbs.; such a race in 2015, 8 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. (Cloudy 66)

INNOVATION ECONOMY bumped at the start lightly by UNITARIAN breaking inwards a step, settled near the rear tucking to the hedge early on, tipped out to the three path into the backside, came under light coaxing the second time past the half mile pole before being put to encouragement in earnest with five-sixteenths to run steadily angling to be seven wide into upper stretch, rallied into prominence a furlong from home confronting UNITARIAN through the final sixteenth head to head, dug in gamely getting bumped nearing the wire when seizing command in the final strides to prevail in the test of stamina. UNITARIAN broke in at the start bumping INNOVATION ECONOMY, raced just off the inside early on before shifting three to four wide into the backside advancing to mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun five to six wide into upper stretch moving well into contention, overhauled the leader nearing the eighth pole, dug in under a drive and cross reined encouragement under challenge to the outside by the aforementioned foe, came out slightly and bumped with that foe nearing the wire and was nailed in the last jumps in a good effort. DYNAMIC SKY saved ground towards the rear early on, shifted to the two path into the far turn, came under urging angled four wide three furlongs from home, angled seven to eighth wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick closing late to garner the show honors. REFLECTING just off the inside in reserve in mid pack content behind cover, got set down angled out to the five path into daylight, offered up a mild kick and kept for the last major share. MORNING CALM saved ground at the rear, came under coaxing half a mile from home, cut the corner into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid to the eighth pole to tepidly threaten inside before weakening in the late stages. ARTIC NORTH just off the pace inside in reserve until put to urging with three furlongs to run, angled three wide at the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch. TATTENHAM rated three wide in mid pack, came under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide for home, weakened in the drive. MANCHURIAN HIGH two to three wide in range of the leader, came under urging three wide with three furlongs to go, spun four wide for home and weakened through the lane. RED RIFLE tracked COMES THE DREAM three wide early on before taking over from that foe after a half, crossed to the inside into the clubhouse turn, showed the way in hand along the inside remaining patiently handled until under pressure nearing the quarter pole, swung just off the inside for home empty and was overhauled straightened away, then gave way through to the wire. COMES THE DREAM led early on along the inside through the opening half then was content to allow RED RIFLE to take over nearing the clubhouse turn, tracked that rival just off the inside in hand until the nearing the five-sixteenths to second time, got put to urging at that juncture, spun three wide into upper stretch for the final time and faltered in the lane.
