COLOR OF COURAGE four wide early, dropped back off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch and gained some ground but was not a serious threat. KINSALE KING stalked the pace a bit off the rail then angled in for the turn, remained inside in the drive and lacked a
