continued on the pace while on the outside, remained in hand when ISN'T HE PERFECT was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when asked in upper stretch, inched clear under left hand urging inside the furlong marker, extended the advantage under continued left hand urging then was hand ridden in the final strides while much the best. ISN'T HE PERFECT came away in front, set the pace on the inside, was joined by SAN PABLO passing the three-quarter pole, came under urging well before the aforementioned rival at the five-sixteenths, was put to a left-handed whip at the top of the stretch, failed to match strides with the winner into the final furlong, moved out under a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and saved the place. ALMA D'ORO was taken in hand early then rated along the inside, drafted behind the leaders on the far turn, was asked while three wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker and narrowly earned the show. HELLO LOVER broke a little over a length behind the field, went three wide on the first turn, settled the outermost of the bunch, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, battled alongside of ALMA D'ORO, was switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and just missed the show.
