STOPCHARGINGMARIA was angled four wide nearing the backstretch and taken to rate, took closer order leaving the far turn, moved under hand urging to engage VERO AMORE into the lane, dueled outside that one through the lane, kept on under right handed encouragement and forged ahead in the final yards. VERO AMORE prompted the pace two wide under confident handling, took over mid way on the final turn, responded when roused into the lane, met the bid of the winner soon after, dueled holding a slim lead past the sixteenth marker, continued gamely but just could not hold in a sharp effort. FORTUNE PEARL, three wide early, advanced between runners heading towards the half mile marker, gave hard chase racing inside rivals leaving the five sixteenths marker, shifted out leaving the three sixteenths and kept on willingly to the wire. JOINT RETURN had her rider briefly lose his left iron after the break, recovered and lagged back, was taken wide for the backstretch run, progressed six wide into the stretch and finished with interest. AMERICA was crowded at the break, settled back off the pace, came four wide for the drive, angled down leaving the eighth pole and had belated action. ARETHUSA, well in hand early, crept closer between rivals near the far turn, steadied when in close between horses in upper stretch, shifted down towards the rail and kept trying to the wire. LA MEJOR FIESTA, bumped then pinched back at the break, raced three wide the first turn, gained five wide between foes in upper stretch, leaned in slightly then flattened out. SHANON NICOLE came in at the break, was unhurried early, picked up some momentum when angled seven wide for the drive but failed to follow through. SLOANE SQUARE, well in hand stalking along the rail on the first turn, was rated back and angled three wide nearing the five eighths pole, gained under a ride between runners leaving the far turn, could not go on into the lane, faded and steadied when in close in upper stretch. EUPHROSYNE saved ground making a run to the half mile pole, was under pressure with three furlongs to go, failed to respond and dropped back. IMAGE OF ANNA angled in clearing into the first turn, set the pace towards the rail, was collared after six furlongs, gave some resistance then faltered in the drive.
