shifted five wide inside the five-sixteenths pole, came six wide into the stretch, rallied on the far outside and closed strongly to get up at the

wire. PLEASANTLY BLESSED was reserved while off the inside, went two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch,

rallied near the center of the course, closed well to get a brief lead inside the sixteenth-pole but was denied at the wire. BET ON THE BLUE

raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, rallied into the

final furlong and closed well but missed. WEEKEND PARTY set the clear pace, responded well when set down in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. A SHE'S ADORABLE lagged at the rear of the field while saving ground, shifted three wide outside the

quarter-pole, moved out some in upper stretch and finished with good energy. DISTORTED LOVE went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. MISS SHANANIEGANS raced three wide on the

first turn, was reserved off the pace, lost position while inside on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. INSTANT STYLE raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased on the far turn and tired. RAVI'S SONG settled on the inside, came off the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. FIGHTER WING followed the leader from second, came up empty on the far turn and faded. (Rail at 0 Feet)
