About 5½ FURLONGS. (Turf) (1.023) STAKES. Purse \$75,000 *BONAPAW S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD*. Free nomination by Saturday, December 7. \$400 to enter and \$400 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 4% to fourth; 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Weight: Three Year Olds - 122 lbs. Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf since October 21, 2013 allowed 2 lbs. \$30,000 on the turf since then allowed 4 lbs. \$25,000 on the turf since September 21, 2013 allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The maximum number of starters for the Bonapaw will be determined by rail setting. Preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings on the turf in 2013. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, December 7, 2013, with 24 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.) (Rail at 15 feet). (Cloudy 75)

Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Apr), by Speightstown - Enjoy the Moment by Slew's Royalty. Trainer Amoss M. Thomas. Bred by Farfellow Farms Ltd.(KY).

SUM OF THE PARTS showed good speed, set the pace, was guided around the turn with left-rein pressure while lugging out a tad, kicked clear in upper stretch and proved much the best under steady urging. CHANNEL MARKER settled on the outside while under some urging, went three then two wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and narrowly earned the place while no match for the winner. STRONG IMPACT was ridden along at the rear, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, was put the whip on the outside and finished willingly to just miss the place. ARTEST was urged along towards the rear, went two then three wide on the turn and improved position. GREAT MILLS brushed with a rival at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure while two to three wide on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and weakened. SAY NO MORE moved in early, was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and tired. EXPECTING CASH was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. HAMILTONIAN was urged along on the outside, chased three to four wide on the turn and tired. TOUR GUIDE settled off the pace, was roused while off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 15 Feet)
