MALIBU HIGH chased the pace on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, rallied along the rail entering the final furlong, gained the lead near the sixteenth-pole and proved best under good handling. AGAVE CAT disputed the pace on the outside, shook clear near the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for his best in upper stretch, drifted out a bit near the furlong marker, lost the advantage passing the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the place. FAVORITE UNCLE was ridden along on the outside, moved closer leaving the backstretch, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. LIMONTE chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn and tired. BACKSTREET HERO brushed with a rival at the start, lacked early speed, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. RIVER CRUISING contested the pace on the inside of AGAVE CAT, vied along the rail on the turn, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into upper stretch then gave way. I'M IN TO SHINE was hard ridden towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and was no factor. REPHRASE brushed with an opponent at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond.
