1 1/2 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.573) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 BOWLING GREEN H. (GRADE II) INNER TURF A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$2,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination payment of \$5,000 in addition to the entry fee can be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters include supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,250 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Dirt weights, Three Year Olds 119 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt in 12-13 allowed 2 lbs.; \$58,000 at a mile or over on the dirt in 2013 allowed 4 lbs.; a sweepstakes or four races on the dirt, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, dirt allowance weights will apply and it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. HYPER well reserved in the two path until the end of the backstretch, departed it four wide, cleared a pair of rivals leaving the five-sixteenths pole and challenged the leader closer to the rail once again, took charge before completing the next eighth then dug in well to preserve the decision. FINNEGANS WAKE unhurried at or near the two path until the five-sixteenths pole, proceeded to get taken outward at that station, was already under solid encouragement spinning four wide into upper stretch, got straightened away with no loss of momentum and came home with good energy to procure the place. BOISTEROUS contently tracked the pacesetter while sitting a loose pocket for nearly a mile, was given some rein and appeared to pick up interest a bit too keenly approaching the quarter pole, got checked hard prior to cutting the corner into the lane, hitting the hedge as a result, while rushing up towards the heels of QUICK CASABLANCA, recovered nicely and got angled outward soon afterwards, lacked the needed response. QUICK CASABLANCA (CHI) came away in good order, was put to a good hold and quickly established control, cut the pace on a loosely-contested lead until the later stages of the run around the far turn, felt a build up in pressure at that stage and get let out in response to it, offered some resistance before yielding to the winner travelling through the furlong grounds, weakened steadily thereafter. LONDON LANE patiently prompted the pacesetter from the two two path, launched an abbreviated bid heading for the quarter pole, had it fizzle out in short order and backed away. FARHAAN sat forwardly placed three wide for a mile before giving way.
