1 1/2 MILES. (Turf) (2,253) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 (US \$483,650) BREEDERS' S. FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS, FOALED IN CANADA. Scale Weight: Colts and Geldings 126 lbs.; Fillies 121 lbs. By subscription of \$500 each to accompany the nomination by May 1, 2013 (73 nominations): to continue eligibility the following additional payments must be made: \$1000 due by July 31, 2013 (11 remained eligible) and an additional \$5000 at time of final entry. Horses not originally nominated may be supplemented at the time of final entry by a non refundable fee of \$12,500 which includes the entry fee. (Closed with 11 Nominations, 1 Supplement) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 2% to fifth, 1 % to sixth, 1% to seventh, 1% to eighth. (No Canadian Bred Allowance). All monies received from the original nomination on May 1, 2013 will be divided equally between the gross purses for the three races, The Queen's Plate, Prince of Wales and Breeders' Stakk es. \$100,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program.*Plus up to \$28,950 Ontario Sired/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. UP WITH THE BIRDS, in midpack early, closed into the far turn, challenged three-wide late turn, dueled into the stretch and drove clear then held sway under a hand ride. **RIVER SEVEN**, off slowly, gained striking range quickly, stalked the pace, bid four-wide late turn, dueled into the stretch, was headed but was all out chasing to the end. **PYRITE MOUNTAIN**, rated off the pace, closed into the far turn, closed into the stretch, hesitated briefly in the final furlong then finished gamely. **GLOBAL EXPRESS** raced in midpack between horses, closed three-wide early on the far turn then launched a determined drive outside rivals. **WHO'S MR. HUGHES** stalked the pace from the rail and was all out in the stretch. **HIGHLAND BAY**, well back and in hand early, angled out closing late turn but was never contentious. **DRAGON PUFF** led quickly, set a reserved pace, was joined late turn, dueled into the stretch and tired. **SCIPIO** settled in midpack, saved ground on the far turn, angled out at the top of the stretch but flattened out. **BOOKIES NIGHTMARE** raced off the pace, came four-wide through the far turn then evened out in the stretch. **FAITHFUL ROSE** moved to the inside quickly after leaving the gate, settled off the pace, chased between rivals late turn but showed no response in the stretch.
