to be along in time. BRIECAT angled in and dueled outside a rival then inched away and angled in nearing the half mile pole, set the pace

inside, kicked clear in the stretch and held on well but was caught late then just saved the place. MALIBU PIER pulled her way into a bit of a

tight spot into the first turn, chased off the rail then inside on the second turn, swung three deep into the stretch, rallied between rivals in deep

stretch, came in some nearing the wire and just missed second. BURG BERG angled in and dueled inside, was in a bit tight a half mile out then saved ground stalking the pace, came out some in the stretch and was outkicked. LILLY FA POOTZ stalked a bit off the rail, moved up

outside leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, continued alongside a foe into the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and steadied in tight nearing the wire. TURNING TOP (IRE) saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LATE CUDDLE (NZ) four wide into the first turn, chased outside a rival then between foes leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. IT TIZ hopped then bobbled in a slow start, went three

deep on the first turn and four wide leaving the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and did not rally. SPRING STYLE (IRE) settled between horses then outside a rival, split foes leaving the backstretch, continued inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. BONNIE BLUE FLAG angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, dropped back leaving the second turn and weakened
