1 1/4 MILES. (1.41) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *BUSHER S. INNER DIRT FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD*. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2014 Kentucky Oaks, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Oaks published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The Busher has also been selected as one of the races in the Kentucky Oaks Championship Series Prep Season. The winner of the Busher will be awarded 10 points, the second place finisher 4 points, the third place finisher 2 points and the fourth place finisher 1 point. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 at a mile or over since October 1 other than restricted stake allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming or starter, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming or starter at a mile or over, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, January 18, 2014 with 19 Nominations. (Clear 43)

JOINT RETURN unhurried early on, saved ground through the first turn, shifted to be two to three wide five furlongs out, took closer order on the front into the far turn, angled to the five path three furlongs from home commencing a solid bid to move into contention, swung five wide outside a quartet on nearly even terms at the head of the stretch, dug in rallying to take over the front a furlong from home, drew clear under a drive geared down in the final strides. **VERO AMORE** three wide in close aim of the front, got set down swinging three wide between foes into upper stretch among a quintet battling for command, dug in steadily gaining through to the eighth pole, proved no match for the top one through the final eighth while fighting on to secure the place. **KETEL TWIST** hustled from the start, attended the pace from the two path well rated, came under encouragement as the pressure intensified at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home between foes, took narrow command straightened away, dug in under challenge from a quartet and was displaced just outside the furlong marker, kept on readily but was headed for the place in the final jumps. **FIERCE BOOTS** hustled from the gate, established the pace in hand along the inside, marshaled the field down the backside under tepid pressure to the three-eighths, had the threat intensify in behind at the five-sixteenths, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch under assault and overwhelmed by a quartet on nearly even terms, was headed straightened away, battled briefly inside to the three-sixteenths before weakening in the final furlong. **BALLYLEE** away a bit awkward at the start, raced just off the inside in close range of the front, got angled four wide immersing herself to keep a path open to the inside of **JOINT RETURN** three furlongs out, bid four wide in tandem with that foe to the outside through the latter portion of the turn, got on nearly even terms with the front swinging four wide into the lane between rivals into prominence, kept on to the three-sixteenths before weakening through the stretch. **MY JIMMY CHEW GIRL** allowed to settle, saved ground towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, got angled four wide at the quarter pole and offered no response. **FLEET OF GOLD** rated tracking the pace in range along the inside, came under encouragement midway on the far turn, cut the corner in behind a quintet into the stretch and tired.
