GOT EVEN sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and drew off in the stretch under left handed urging. EXOTIC SLEW stalked the pace off the rail to the stretch and got up between foes late for the place. PASSING GAME saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the turn, swung out into the stretch and just missed second three deep on the line. JOHNNY BE MINE had good early speed then stalked the winner just off the inside to the stretch and was edged late for a minor award. STONEY FLEECE bobbed in an awkward start, settled off the inside, split horses into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CRIMSON GIANT settled just off the rail then along the inside to the stretch and did not rally. MOTOWN MEN stumbled badly at the start, went up between foes then chased off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. HEART FEVER dropped back outside then off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and failed to menace. FOREVER FREEDOM came off the rail and chased outside a rival or off the inside, went alongside a rival again on the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened.
