ISMENE sprinted to the early lead off the rail, retained a short lead into the turn, began to draw clear leaving the turn and proved best under a hand ride in the final furlong. WILLA B AWESOME chased the pace three wide into and around the turn, came into the stretch four wide, rallied in the final furlong and held the place while no threat to the winner. WARREN'S AMBER chased the pace between foes into and around the turn, came into the lane three wide and held the show between horses. TANGERINE TICKLE was off slowly, chased on the inside down the backstretch, swung out for the stretch drive and improved her position. ALMOST A LADY chased the pace inside rivals into and around the turn, was in tight and steadied on the inside at the three sixteenths marker and weakened through the final furlong. BELLOMA stalked or pressed the pace inside the winner down the backstretch and into the turn, could not keep pace with that one nearing the quarter pole and weakened on the inside through the lane.
