BOLD CHIEFTAIN came off the rail early and stalked the pace, angled out into the stretch, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and proved best under left handed urging. LETHAL HEAT stalked early then prompted the pace outside a rival, inherited a short lead past midstretch, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. STAR NICHOLAS saved ground chasing the pace, came out past midstretch and edged a rival for the show. ONE CHIN AGAIN allowed to settle outside a rival chasing the pace, came out some in the stretch, angled in off heels past the eighth pole and was edged for third. GRAZEN took the early lead off the rail, angled in on the first turn and set a pressured pace inside, inched away under some urging again in the drive then was pulled up past the eighth pole and vanned off. BLACKBRIAR chased a bit off the rail or inside, came out into the stretch, took a bad step in midstretch and also was pulled up and vanned off.
