QUISISANA pulled her way along to stalk the pace a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, bid between foes past the eighth pole and held third. WARREN'S R READY sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back past midstretch and weakened some late. UNZIP ME pulled a bit and

stalked the pace inside, came out in upper stretch, steadied in tight between horses nearing midstretch and was outfinished. STRAWBERRY TART chased outside then three deep on the hill, came out six wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. GOLDEN

DOC A broke inward and slowly, settled just off the rail, came out leaving the hill and well wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. UNWORLDLY HEAT pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, bid along the rail in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SHE'S VERY RARE dropped back off the rail, angled in some on the hill, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. SPEEDIN EXCESS a bit slow to begin, settled inside then just off the rail, angled three deep into the stretch and did not rally. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
