CENTURY PARK fanned wide into the stretch the first time, angled in and stalked off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn, took a short lead, fought back under urging in the stretch and held gamely between foes late. CATSALOT broke out a bit, settled inside, moved up into the second turn, came out into the stretch and finished well three deep on the line. YOU LIFT ME UP drifted out into the stretch the first time, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, dueled along the fence on the second turn, fought back in the stretch and bested the others. ROLLERSKATES allowed to settle off the rail then outside a rival, went up three deep leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, fell back again on that bend, angled in some and weakened. NOVATO angled in and stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses approaching the second turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
