LADY RAILRIDER pulled early and stalked inside, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, bid three deep leaving the second turn and in the stretch, gained the lead approaching the sixteenth pole and proved best under urging. SMOOTH PERFORMER stalked a bit off the rail then outside a rival, bid alongside the leader then between horses on the second turn and into the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch and held second. HOT N' DUSTY angled in and chased a bit off the rail, went three and four wide on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and was edged for the place. GAMBLER'S JUSTICE stalked early then bid outside a rival and took the lead on the backstretch, inched away and angled in, fought back along the rail on the second turn and until deep stretch and was outfinished. ALE'S PRIDE pulled her way to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside then stalked along the rail, dropped back on the second turn, came out in the stretch and gave way.
