RUSSIAN GREEK took back early and raced unhurried to the second turn, commenced his bid from the three path on the second turn, angled to the extreme outside for the drive and offered a bold rally to tag CAHILL CHROME late and won going away driving. CAHILL CHROME tracked the leaders three wide from the outset, offered his bid four wide mid way on the second turn, forged to the front nearing the furlong pole but could not quite stall the winner. SENOR RAIN settled early from the rail and raced under patient handling while always within striking distance, shifted to the four path on the second turn, rallied into the stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. HODGE stalked the pace from off the rail throughout, gained command two wide on the second turn but gradually weakened in the lane. UNVEILED HEAT was well positioned from the outset, had his bid three wide and between horses on the second turn and slackened in the lane. BLACKY THE BULL raced unhurried early three wide, then failed to respond while four wide on the second turn. RECONSTRUCTION broke to the outside but quickly recovered and sprinted to the lead, led to the second turn but gave way and had nothing left to be eased in the stretch.
